Minutes of the hearing held on 05.07.2024 before the National Commission for Scheduled Castes, New Delhi


The hearing of the case of Shri Sonu S/o Shri Kunwar Singh Valmiki R/o Village Saiman, Pana Todar, Tehsil Meham, District Rohtak, Haryana regarding release of grant under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojna to SCs families was held on 05.07.2024 before the National Commission for Scheduled castes, New Delhi.

Shri Manish Malik, Dy. C.E.O., Zila Parishad, Rohtak, Development & Panchayat Department, Shri Manjeet, D.E.O., PMAYG, District Rohtak Govt. of Haryana were present for hearing before the National Commission for Scheduled Castes. The petitioner was also present.

The case was discussed in detail. The petitioner intimated to the Commission that a survey was conducted by the Gram Panchayat Saiman Survey Committee 3-4 years ago for providing houses under the Pradhan Mantri Gramin Awas Yojana. In which about 25 families of village Saiman were enrolled in the category of getting the benefits of the scheme. But not a single family received the benefit of the said scheme. Therefore, the applicant has requested the Commission to provide grant amount for the house under the Pradhan Mantri Gramin Awas yojna.

The Chief Executive Officer, Zila Parishad/ DRDA, Rohtak sent a report in the case. The Dy. CEO apprised the Commission that during 2021-22 there was target of only 6 houses in village Saiman of the District of Rohtak under the scheme and out of target 6 houses, 4 houses were allotted to SCs families and 2 to other castes families in the ratio of 60:40 for SCs and Others respectively. The District Rohtak has not received grant under PMAY Scheme during the year 2022-23 and 2023-24 from Central Government, therefore grant to waitlisted beneficiaries have not been released. As soon as Government release the grant under the PMAY scheme, the waitlisted SCs families will be given grant on priority.

After hearing the parties, it is observed that the Government has not released grant under PMAY during the year 2022-23 and 2023-24, therefore grant to waitlisted SC beneficiaries have not been released. Therefore, Commission recommends that grant to waitlisted SCs beneficiaries be released on priority as soon as Government releases the grant under the Scheme. With this recommendation, the case is closed.
