

GOVERNMENT OF INDIA NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED CASTES (A Constitutional body set up under Article 338 of the Constitution of India) <u>ESDW/IP/DL/2023/227546</u>

Minutes of the hearing held on 05.07.2024 before the National Commission for Scheduled Castes, New Delhi

The hearing of the case of Shri Vikas Karotiya S/o Smt. Bina Karotiya R/o Dakshinpuri, New Delhi regarding not giving Tehbazari in South Delhi even after allotment was held on 05.07.2024 before the National Commission for Scheduled Castes, New Delhi.

Shri Kumar Abhishek, Deputy Commissioner, M.C.D. and Shri Aashish Kumar, Assistant Commissioner, South Zone, Municipal Corporation of Delhi were present for hearing before the National Commission for Scheduled Castes. The petitioner's mother was present.

The case was discussed in detail. The petitioner informed the Commission that the South Zone, Green Park Delhi Municipal Corporation has issued a letter no. 3478/AC/SZ/2013 dated 01.05.2014 for Tehbazari allotment. But even after submitting the necessary documents, the applicant did not receive Tehbazari. The Deputy Commissioner, South Zone intimated that Department has examined the request of petitioner for allotment of Tehbazari and it was observed that applicant is a COV holder bearing URI no.8797440 and was allowed to vend as per terms and condition of street venders (Protection of livelihood and regulation of street Vending) Act, 2014. He was allowed Tehbazari after 1st survey done under TVC –I in this regard and after 2nd survey under TVC-II, he will be given select location/zone in south Delhi for vending as per terms and condition of Act, 2014. The TVC II survey is under process.

After hearing both the parties, the Commission observed that 2nd round of survey is under process and after completing the survey all the applicants will be allotted selected vending zone in South Delhi. The Commission recommends that whole issue may be examined and as soon as 2nd survey of TVC II is completed, the petitioner may be allotted selected vending Zone on priority basis so that he can earn his livelihood peacefully. The Dy. Commissioner has also assured that petitioner will not be harassed. With this recommendation, the case is disposed of.
